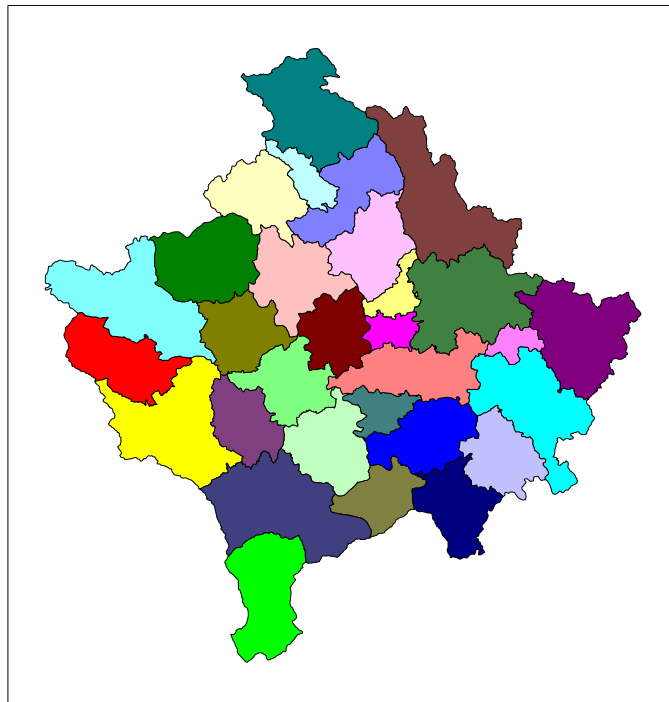

Kosovo is a territory in centre of Balkan Peninsula, with no access to a sea. Kosovo borders with Serbia in Northeast, Macedonia (FYROM) in South, Albania in Southwest and Montenegro in Northwest. The area of Kosovo is 10.908¹ km². The climate in Kosovo is continental with warm summers and cold winters. Kosovo is densely populated with about 193 persons per km², and divided into 30 municipalities. The capital is Prishtina.

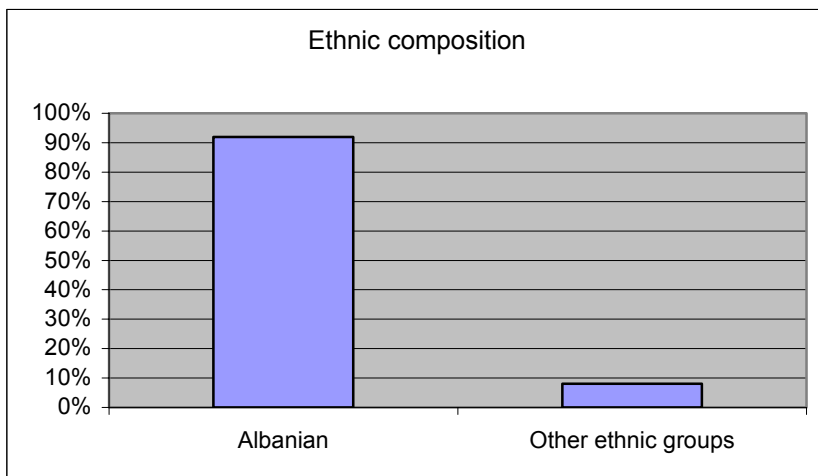

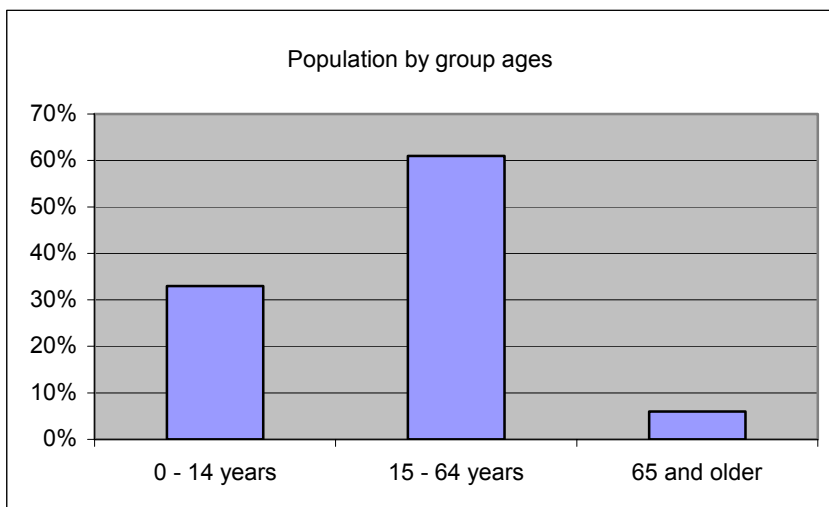

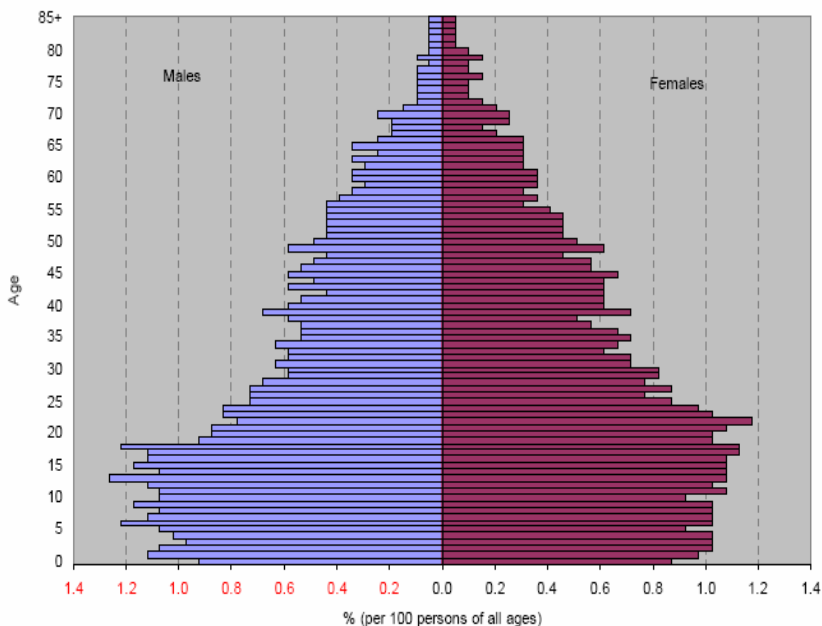

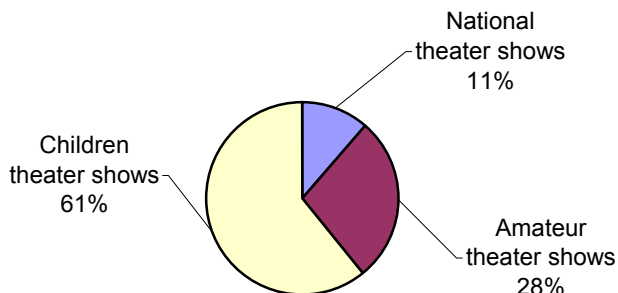

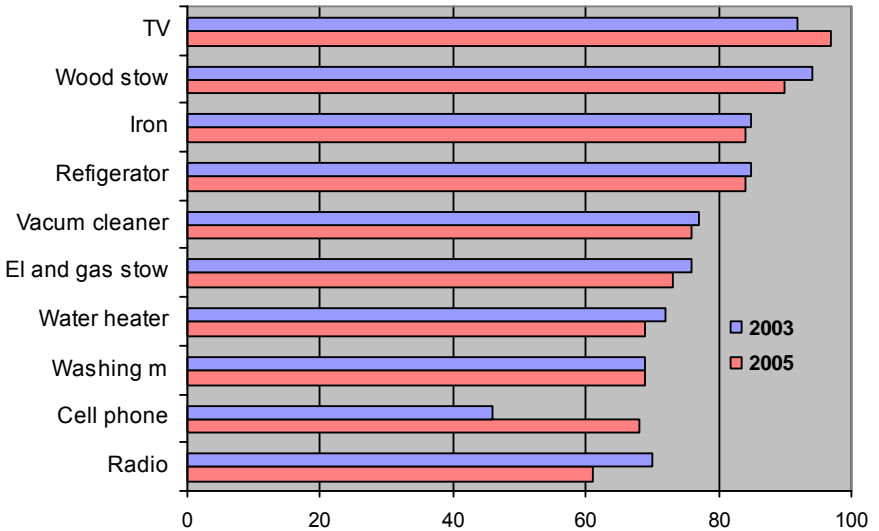

7.2 Most wanted lasting items in Kosovo, (percentage of households that have the items)

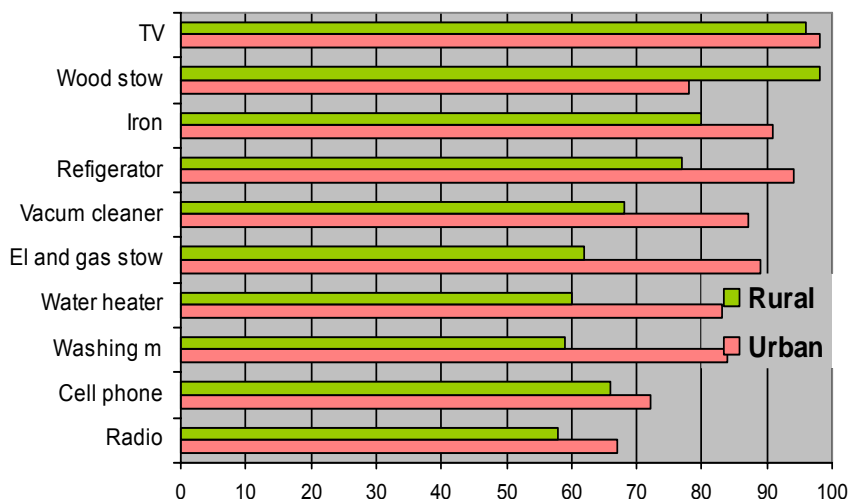

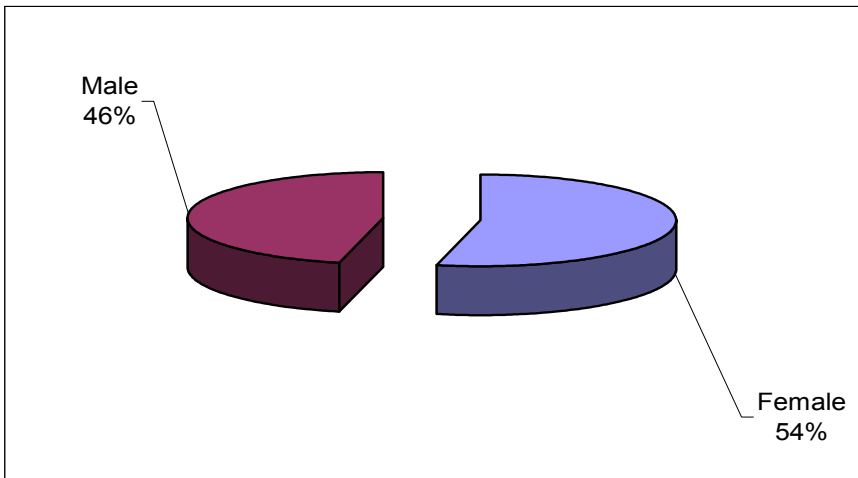

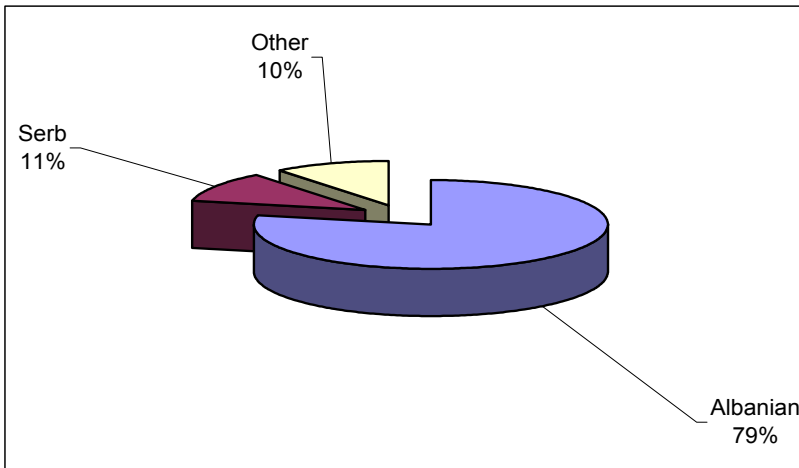

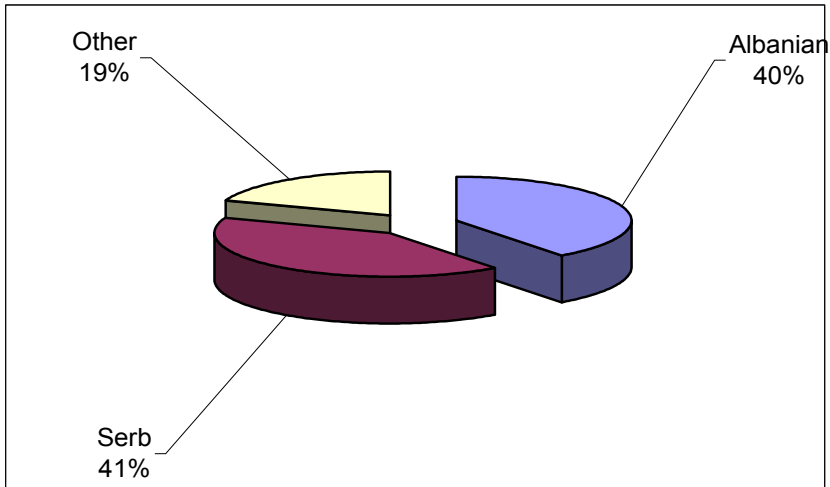

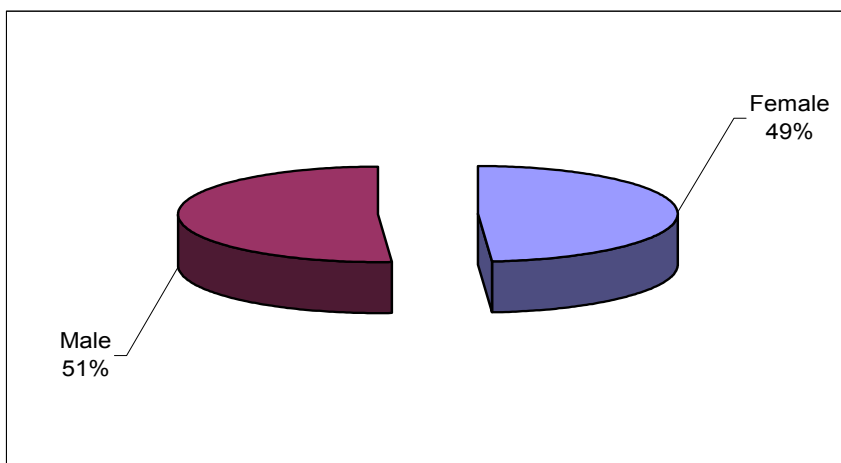

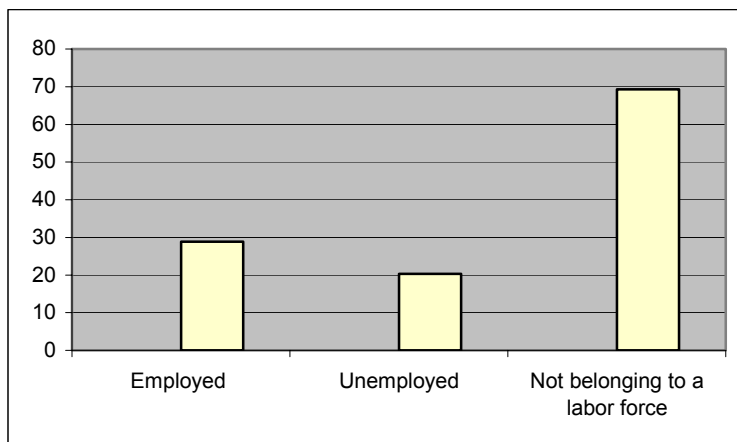

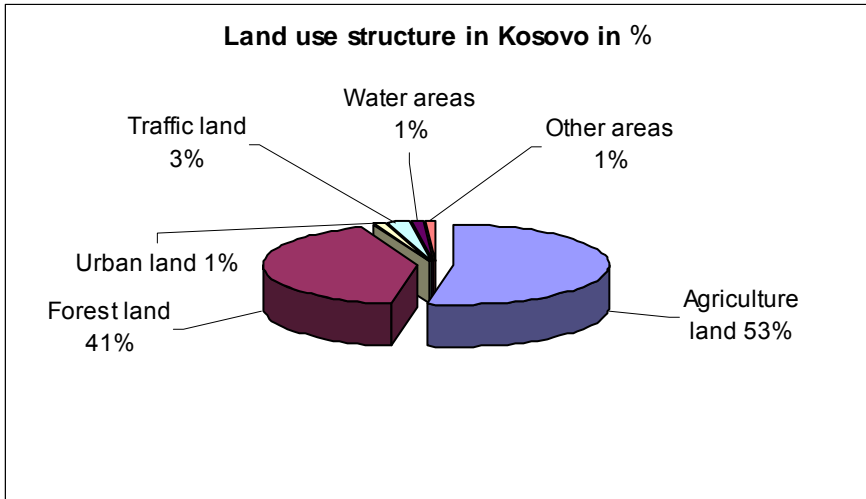

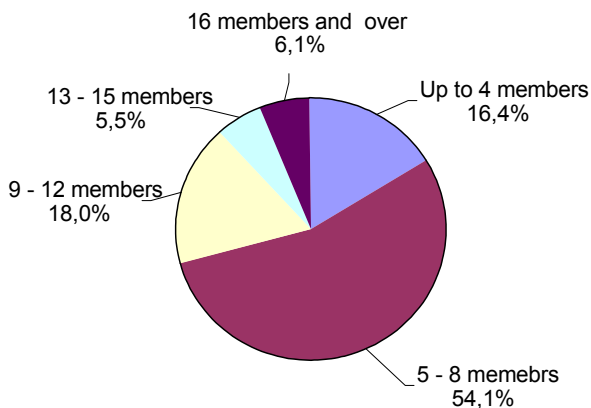
